INDICATIVE MOOD

Perfect Tense  
(Perfect Stem)

v-ī	<i>I praised</i>	<i>(I have praised)</i>
v-istī	<i>you praised</i>	<i>(you have praised)</i>
v-it	<i>he, she, it praised</i>	<i>(he, she, it has praised)</i>
v-imus	<i>we praised</i>	<i>(we have praised)</i>
v-istis	<i>you praised</i>	<i>(you have praised)</i>
v-ērunt	<i>they praised</i>	<i>(they have praised)</i>

Pluperfect Tense

(Perfect Stem and the Imperfect of sum)

v-eram	<i>I had praised</i>
v-erās	<i>you had praised</i>
v-erat	<i>he, she, it had praised</i>
v-erāmus	<i>we had praised</i>
v-erātis	<i>you had praised</i>
v-erant	<i>they had praised</i>

Future Perfect Tense  
(Perfect Stem)

v-erō	<i>I shall have praised</i>
v-eris	<i>you will have praised</i>
v-erit	<i>he, she, it will have praised</i>
v-erimus	<i>we shall have praised</i>
v-eritis	<i>you will have praised</i>
v-erint	<i>they will have praised</i>
