This curriculum could be made less aggressive as it suits the individual school by moving classes to older grades and/or eliminating more advanced Latin courses.

First Form Latin (and its sequels, *Second*, *Third*, and *Fourth Form Latin*) can be substituted for *Henle*. *First Form* is to be published in the fall of 2007, the others in succeeding years.

Written quizzes with keys are currently available for every level up to *Henle II*, and an online quiz package will be available for *Latina Christiana I-Henle II* by the Fall of 2008.
