## ERRATA

Due to the release of *Christian Studies IV: A Chronological Overview of the Bible, Second Edition* in August 2021, we have reprinted the *Christian Studies IV Student Guide* and *Teacher Guide* with corrections to bring the wording of fill-in-the-blanks into conformity with the text. If you are using an older copy of the *Christian Studies IV Teacher Guide* with a new copy of the *Christian Studies IV Student Guide*, you will need to know the following *Teacher Guide* corrections. Answers are included with the fill-in-the-blanks only where the answers also have been modified. A separate download includes the *Christian Studies Drill Questions* that have been reordered to better follow biblical order (where possible). Edits are as follows:

- p. 4, *fill-in-the-blank 1*: Answer: "Orthodox: 49\*; Protestant: 39; Catholic: 46." We have also added the following asterisked note in the *Teacher Guide*: "Orthodox Christians vary in the number of books they include, but students are only required to know/supply '49' in this guide."
- p. 4, *fill-in-the-blank 3*: "Another word for 'testament' is \_\_\_\_\_."
- p. 5, *fill-in-the-blank 2*: Answer: "Neviim."
- p. 5, *fill-in-the-blank 3*: Answer: "Ketuvim."
- p. 15, *Deuteronomy, Outline, fill-in-the-blank 1*: "The book is comprised of Moses' farewell message to the people by clarifying the \_\_\_\_\_ law \_\_\_\_\_ and recounting the history of \_\_\_\_\_ Israel \_\_\_\_\_."
- p. 16, *Facts to Know, 1st fill-in-the-blank*: "49" added to the answer.
- p. 20, *Joshua, Outline, fill-in-the-blank 3*: The primary answer is now "Promised Land," but we have added the following asterisked note in the *Teacher Guide*: "'Canaan' and/or 'the land of milk and honey' are also acceptable."
- p. 22, *Outline, fill-in-the-blank 5*: "city" changed to "capital city."
- p. 22, *Outline, fill-in-the-blank 7*: "Though David should be with his troops in battle, he carries and steals Bathsheba, the wife of \_\_\_\_\_."
- p. 22, *I & II Chronicles, Time period covered within the book*: Answer: "1010-536 B.C."
- p. 29, *Esther, Key People, fill-in-the-blank 4*: "the plot to kill the king" replaced "Haman's plot."
- p. 35, *Outline, fill-in-the-blank 3*: Answer: "love and mercy."
- p. 39, *Micah continued, Outline, fill-in-the-blank 2*: "Messianic King" added alongside "new ruler" to the answer.
- p. 40, *Habakkuk, Outline, fill-in-the-blank 1*: "Habakkuk, in his dialogue with God, complains about..."
- p. 40, *Zephaniah, Outline, fill-in-the-blank 1*: "called the Day of the Lord." added to the end of the sentence.
- p. 41, *Lamentations, Outline*: "mourn the destruction of the temple" added after "God's forgiveness" answer blank.
- p. 42, *Daniel, Outline, fill-in-the-blank 1*: "that he built himself" added after "Nebuchadnezzar" answer blank.
- p. 44, *Zechariah, Outline, fill-in-the-blank 2*: "Jerusalem" replaced "Judah."

- p. 46, *Old Testament Prophets*:
  - *Isaiah*, (5th fill-in-the-blank): "revealed God's plan to restore Israel and bless the world through the Messiah"
  - *Zephaniah*, (8th fill-in-the-blank): "first prophet to describe the coming final judgment of all nations"
  - *Joel*, (14th fill-in-the-blank): "prophet who described the coming Day of the Lord and called Judah to repent"
  - *Zechariah*, (16th fill-in-the-blank): "restore" replaced "guide."

- p. 63, *Memory Verses*: Corrected the reference to "Mark 8:34-37."
- p. 64, *Outline*, *fill-in-the-blank 1*: "Before Jesus ascended into heaven He promised the disciples that He would give them the \_\_\_\_\_ and they would become His witnesses to..."
