

# Student Guidelines

1. Students should hold pencils properly.

2. Start each line close to the left margin and don't cross the right margin.
3. Uppercase letters must touch the top and bottom lines.
4. Most lowercase letters start at the middle, dashed line.
5. Lowercase b, d, f, h, k, t, and l are all tall letters that touch the top line.
6. Lowercase g, j, p, q, and y have hooks or tails that cross the bottom line.
7. All words should be one pinky space apart.
8. Letters should all stand tall and straight.
9. Erase mistakes completely and be neat.
