- The date for "Baptism of Clovis and St. Benedict" has been changed in the *Timeline Program* to A.D. 496 to better reflect contemporary accounts of Clovis' baptism as well as the date given in *Famous Men of the Middle Ages* for this event. Very few dates in St. Benedict's life are certain, but a range of 496-500 A.D. is often given by historians to mark the era that Western Monasticism grew out of.
- The Third Millennium technically began in the year A.D. 2001. It is the two thousandth and first year after the birth of Christ according to the Gregorian Calendar.
