

SUGGESTED SUPPLY LIST

ITEMS CONTINUED FROM PREVIOUS LEVELS

- Playdough** (homemade or store-bought)

Ingredients:

- 2 cups flour
- 1 cup salt
- 1 tbsp oil
- 3/4 cup water
- 2-3 drops food coloring (or divide into sections before adding 1-2 drops per portion)

Directions: Combine flour and salt. Add oil, water, and coloring. If too sticky, add more flour. Knead. Store in a sealed container.

- Plastic knife, child's playdough rolling pin**

- Glue, glue stick, or paste**

- Construction paper**

- Sidewalk chalk**
