- **Unit V, Section V, C7:** *Viserant* should be *viderant*.

- **Unit I, Section I, #8:** Students should write that they have learned **36** forms of *amo* (six tenses with six forms per tense).
- **Unit II, Section IV, #2:** The answer to the third question should be *oppugnabis* (2nd person singular).
