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## Grading

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The following are suggestions only. Feel free to modify them according to the needs of your student(s).

For a thorough grading scheme that serves as a judge of a student's ability in particular language skills, we recommend the following weighted scale:

**Vocabulary: 10 total points.** Divide 10 by the number of vocabulary entries to determine the points to assign to each entry; e.g., if a quiz has 8 vocabulary words:  $10/8 = 1.25$  points per vocabulary entry. When *First* or *Second Form Greek* has given multiple meanings, students only need to provide one.

**Grammar: 10 total points.** Consider each blank line, space in a chart, or distinct part of a question a single entry. Particularly long answers may be assigned more points at the teacher's discretion. Divide 10 by the number of entries to determine the points to assign to each entry; e.g., if a quiz has 5 entries:  $10/5 = 2$  points per grammar entry.

**Principal Parts: 15 total points.** Consider every empty space in the chart a single entry (a hyphen means the given verb does not occur in a specific principal part. Because Greek principal parts can be very difficult, we have provided the hyphen for students in all quizzes and tests). Divide 15 by the number of entries to determine the points to assign to each entry; e.g., if a quiz has 16 entries:  $15/16 = .94$  (rounded up) points per principal part entry.
