Quiz 6: C. Translate. #8: verb in answer should be *dederunt*, not *dedit*.

Unit 1 Review Test: p. 2. D: says to decline *integer*, but should be *aeger*.

Quiz 8: C. Translate. #4: *provincia* should be *provinciam*.

#5: answer should be *debita*, not *peccata* (*peccatum* not taught yet).

Student Text:

p. 22: Third Declension Adjectives. Ablative Plural: should be *brevibus*, not *brvvibus*.

p. 42: Vocabulary: definition of *veho* should be: *to convey, transport* (remove *carry*).

p. 94: last diagrammed sentence: *gift* should be marked *DO*, not *IO*.

Mark should be marked *OP*, not *PO*.

p. 98: Third Declension Neuter. Ablative Plural: should be *fluminibus*, not *flumvribus*.

Vocabulary Index (Latin to English): *inter* - remove *among*; definition should be *between*
lacrima - word is not taught in Second Form

Vocabulary Index (English to Latin): *among* - remove *inter*; Latin should be *apud*
tear - word is not taught in Second Form
