

# SUPPLY LIST

---

**Playdough (homemade or store-bought)**

**Ingredients:**

- 2 cups flour
- 1 cup salt
- 1 tbsp oil
- 3/4 cup water
- 2-3 drops food coloring (or divide into sections before adding 1-2 drops per portion)

**Directions:** Combine flour and salt. Add oil, water, and coloring. If too sticky, add more flour. Knead. Store in a sealed container.

**Cookie sheet or jelly roll pan**

**Child's rolling pin**

## **Ingredients for (Bilateral Fine-Motor) Kitchen Activities**

- chocolate chip cookie dough mix (week 2)
- instant pudding, spoon or whisk, large bowl (week 6)
- peanut butter, jelly, bread (week 6)
- fresh fruit for fruit salad (grapes, bananas, pears, oranges) (weeks 6-7)
- peanut butter, celery, raisins (week 7)
- fresh green leafy lettuce & spinach, sunflower seeds, dried cranberries for tossed salad (weeks 7-8)
- empty oatmeal container (week 9)
- mini marshmallows, raisins, Cheerios, cheese cubes, pretzels (week 10)
- empty, clean tuna can or other circle for cutting playdough (week 17)

## **Items for Self-Help Fine-Motor Activities**

- spare shirts, jackets, pants, shoes, mittens, gloves; doll or stuffed animal clothing – especially with large buttons, zippers, snaps, laces (weeks 14, 16, 23, 34)
- keys, locks, knobs (week 25)

## **Items for (Gross-Motor) Coordination, Balance, and Strength**

- wagon or doll stroller
- push toy or riding toy
- pedaling toy
- playground with equipment for preschoolers
- balls – toddler soccer, basketball, baseball with t-stand, golf
- balloons (week 33)
